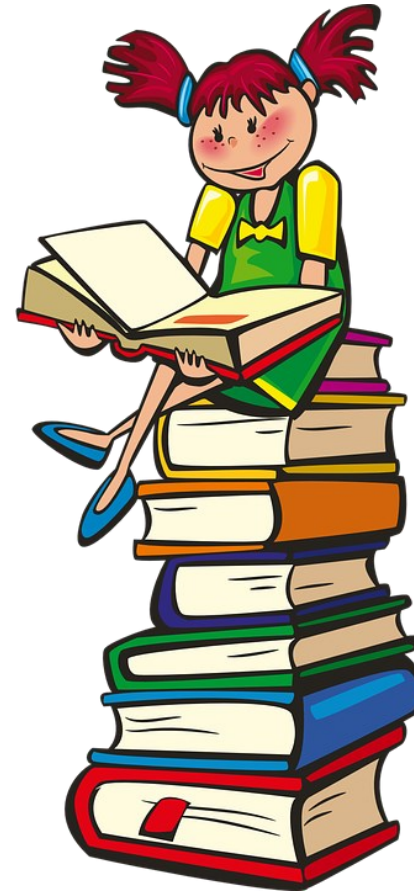

Book Bingo Instructions:

1. Read books that fit Bingo criteria between **Friday, December 22nd & Wednesday, February 28th.**
2. Reading with a parent or a sibling counts! Audiobooks count!
3. Write the title of each book you read in the appropriate square. Each title may **ONLY BE USED ONE TIME** (no matter how many times you read it).
4. **Beginning January 2nd**, bring your Bingo Board to the library when you have completed a Bingo (five in a row in any direction—horizontal, vertical, or diagonal).
5. For your first Bingo, you will receive a coupon for a free visit to a state park and a *first entry* to the drawing.
6. For your second Bingo, you will receive a water bottle and a *second entry* to the grand prize drawing.
7. If you complete the entire Bingo Board, you will receive a book and a *third entry* to the grand prize drawing.
8. We will hold drawings during the day on **Thursday, January 25th** and **Thursday, March 1st**. Because we are under construction, there will be no special event.
