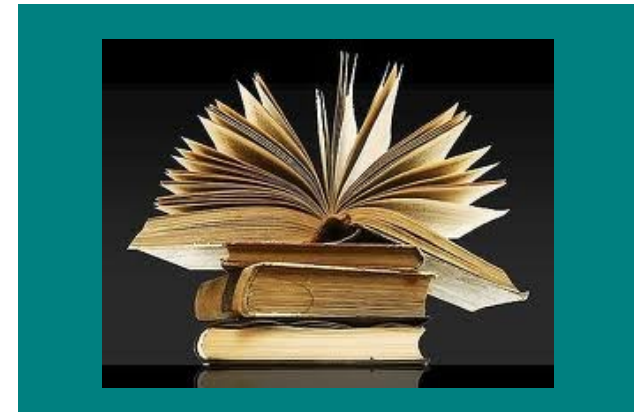

## Who We Are

The Friends of the Library serve to assist and support the full range of library functions. The FOL is a non-profit and non-partisan organization.

The friends offer diverse, monthly programs...discussions about our community, past and present; local railroad history, local retired professors who bring their expertise, world-travel slide shows and lectures and local authors sharing their written treasures.

The Friends are instrumental in raising money for the library, providing assistance in the library when special help is needed and conducting outreach and educational programs.

## What We Do

Our primary fundraiser and service to the community is a monthly used book sale.

Our book sales have enabled the FOL to donate over \$200,000 to the library for the purchase of materials and equipment to better serve our patrons of the East Bonner County Free Library District.

## Book Sorting

On the fourth Wednesday morning of every month, members sort through book donations to prepare for the next book sale.

On the first Saturday of every month from 10:00 AM—2:00 PM we hold a sale of used, withdrawn and donated books. We also have magazines, CDs, DVDs and videos available for sale.

Donations of these items are accepted on sale days or can be left at the information and/or circulation desks at the library.

A cart with sale items also is available inside the library lobby and on a cart near the entrance into the library itself.

The Friends always welcome help with these activities.
